

FARCET CEMETERY REGULATIONS

1. The Cemetery will be open for interments seven days a week
2. All fees and charges are to be paid to the Clerk in advance.
3. A Registrar's Certificate of Coroners Order for burial must be delivered at time of notice of intending interment
4. All damage to paths, gate, headstones etc. to be notified to the Parish Clerk and made good by those responsible for such damage.
5. The reservation of a grave space, the exercise of a right of burial or the erection of a memorial does not confer upon the relatives of the deceased, or upon any other person, any right of ownership of the land in which the burial is (or is to be) made.
The reservation of a grave, does not reserve a grave number. Reservation of a grave number can be requested from the Clerk and WILL ONLY BE granted in exceptional circumstances.
6. The Parish Council reserves the right to remove any objects introduced into the cemetery in contravention of these regulations or for which permission has not been obtained or which cause difficulty for Cemetery maintenance. Photographs, candles, lights and other appendages must not be placed on graves
7. Within twelve months of interment all graves are to be grassed over by either the person responsible for the interment or the Parish Council who reserve the right to make a charge if they carry out the work. No plants or shrubs to be planted in the grave area.
8. Eco coffins only to be used for earthen grave interments (please contact the clerk for further details).
9. Headstones will be limited to the following maximum dimensions:-
3ft wide by 3ft high for single graves
6ft-wide by 3ft high for double graves
10. Only tablets 18" x 18" will be allowed in the area allocated for the interment of ashes.
11. No curbstones or fencing around graves is permitted.
Two heavy vase or container for flowers, with the approval of the Parish Council, is allowed and must be located only around the area of a headstone.
12. Headstones shall not be erected until at least 6 months have elapsed from interment.
13. Headstones, tablets, vases and if artificial flowers are used these are to be kept in good repair by owners.
14. Intended inscriptions on headstones and tablets are to be approved by the Council before location.

- 15. Plans and elevations of headstones, tablets and vases are to be approved by the Council before location
- 16. The Council will not be responsible for any accident occasioned to headstones and vases by storm, wind, lightening or any other cause except by their own negligence.
- 17. Dogs (EXCEPT GUIDE DOGS) will not be allowed entrance to the Cemetery.
- 18. All dead flowers and wreaths shall be removed from graves and placed In the bins provided.
- 19. Christmas wreaths are allowed in the cemetery. Any Christmas wreaths still remaining on graves by the end of January will be removed. Flowers for burials and memorials will be removed after one month.
- 20. All persons in the Cemetery must conduct themselves in an orderly manner.
- 21. Applications for reserved places to be made to the Parish Clerk. (Refer to para 5)
- 22. Within the Cemetery, only qualified undertakers are permitted to carry out excavations for any interments
- 23. The Parish Council which is the Authority for the Cemetery reserves the right to alter or revise these Regulations as they deem appropriate
