An auction will be held on Tuesday 13 February 2018 when individuals will receive a personal offer, and can then decide whether to switch to the winning supplier. The rates are exclusive to residents through the scheme and are not available elsewhere. There is no obligation for people to accept an offer, but if you do the new provider will take care of the whole process.
